



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1 When will the conference take place?

NTI will still be held from November 11-13, 2020, and all sessions will take place on Zoom. Attendees will receive Zoom links and more information via email closer to the conference dates. The Child Sex Abuse (CSA) section meeting will still take place on Tuesday, November 10th from 9am-5pm.

2 How many sessions can I watch?

All of them! Select sessions, as well as all plenaries, will be live-streamed during the normal conference times on November 11-13. All registered attendees will also receive a flash drive via mail that contains all conference sessions that are not being live streamed. This will allow you to watch them at your leisure or refer back to the content at a later date!

3 Can I still get CLEs?

Yes! CLEs will only be available for live sessions as normal. However, this will not reduce the amount of hours you would typically be able to receive, as usually attendees could only attend one session per time slot in the past. Staff will be monitoring all live sessions to confirm attendance. Please note that CLE requirements may be different this year due to the conference taking place virtually as opposed to in person as normal.

4 Is the registration price reduced since the conference is virtual?

Absolutely. The conference price has been decreased drastically to reflect the differences in a virtual event. As a reminder, NCVBA members receive a \$50 discount on registration by using the code **2020NCVBAM**. 5 Will I be able to network with other attendees and presenters during the event?

Yes! We are currently working on the best option for networking. This will likely involve an online group (ex: Facebook, Google groups) for attendees to meet, chat, and engage with presenters.
