Narrative Report

My professional activities have been based in my work at McLean Hospital and the treatment of complex and often acutely ill psychiatric patients. In recent years, up to 70% of my effort has involved administrative responsibility for oversight of hospital programs and operations, and I have devoted as much as 10% of my time to teaching and research. However, I remain fundamentally a clinician, and my all my professional activities remain linked to my clinical practice.

Beginning in the early 1980s, I developed a special interest in the psychiatric sequelae of childhood traumatization. I have headed efforts to define the specific clinical syndromes that result from severe and persistent early abuse, and to formulate effective treatment programs for adults with backgrounds of such abuse. Through clinical work and clinical research I—and the colleagues who have worked with me—have begun to understand the diverse symptoms that these patients present including dissociative and post-traumatic symptomatology, difficulties with characterologic development, and associated problems with addictions, eating disorders and somatization.

I have developed treatment programs for adult survivors of abuse and formally opened the Dissociative Disorders Program in 1990, which now includes inpatient services, partial hospitalization, and a women's residential program. Along with other nationally recognized experts in the study of traumatic stress, I have contributed to the development of a treatment model that has become the standard of practice for trauma-related disorders. This treatment model emphasizes treatment staging, building a firm foundation of ego functioning and containment of symptoms prior to embarking on any major abreactive treatment.

I have been recognized as an expert witness in the area of the treatment of patients with trauma-related disorders, including suits concerning allegations of improper treatment, clergy abuse, and recovered memory. I have provided consultation and testimony in numerous civil suits and criminal prosecutions including several high profile cases.

I have organized numerous conferences, workshops, and seminars that have offered the most recent advances in understanding and treating trauma-related disorders. I have been active in the specialty organization in my area of interest, the International Society for the Study of Trauma and Dissociation (ISSD) since its inception in 1984, and founded a New England affiliated component society. I have served as president of the ISSD and have received awards from that organization for distinguished achievements in the field. For six years, I served as the Editor of the *Journal of Trauma and Dissociation*, the official journal of the ISSD. I was the chief architect of the official ISSD Guidelines for the Treatment of Dissociative Identity Disorder in Adults. I am a Fellow of the ISSD and a Distinguished Fellow the American Psychiatric Association.

As a principal investigator, I have directed a number of (unfunded) research projects that helped establish the prevalence of histories of childhood abuse and psychiatric symptomatology in adult psychiatric patients. Our studies have also identified the parameters of abuse experiences—severity, chronicity, early age of onset, and intrafamilial abuse—that make them more likely to be to have long-term effects. I have also led efforts to study traumatic memory, including identifying the prevalence of dissociative amnesia and recovered memory in adult psychiatric patients with histories of abuse. We have published reports investigating the validity of reports of childhood abuse, and the relationship between recovered memory of abuse and psychotherapeutic practices.
